Planned Activities

Partner Meeting

realized in Venice, Italy, in the period 30/11/2018-01/11/2018

The first meeting was organized by the coordinator UNIVE to discuss the project and plan all the activities.

The activities carried out were:

- presentation of the entire project initiative;

Staff Training

realized in Kirsehir, Turkey, in the period 21/01/2019-25/01/2019

The training course was organized and hosted by Turkish partner KIRSEHIR VALILIGI.

- the main objective was the social integration of refugees and migrants;
- 2 people took part from each of the project partners;
- the visit to the employment centre - ISKUR - revealed possibilities to enter the labour market by starting new business ventures.



In the beginning of 2016, Turkey amended its legislation to enable refugees to take up work legally.

Syrian refugees are now able to obtain a work permit and gain access to the vocational education and training system.



- Kirşehir hosts more than 14.000 refugees mainly from Iraq, Syria and Afghanistan.
- In an overall ranking by the Migration Policy Group measuring immigrant integration policies in 28 countries, Sweden scored most points.

Partner Organizations

Università Ca 'Foscari di Venezia



Ca' Foscari University has an outstanding reputation for academic excellence in both teaching and research. Established in 1868 as a Royal Business College, Ca' Foscari University was the first educational institution in Italy to offer higher education in business and economics and the second in Europe.

Ca' Foscari offers 4 main subject areas of teaching and research activities (economics, humanities, languages and sciences). After the reorganization of the academic structure, following the Bologna Process, Ca' Foscari offers 23 First Cycle Degree Programmes and 38 Second Cycle Degree Programmes, 38 Specialist Master's Programmes, 15 PhD Programmes. Students can choose among 21 international Double and Joint Degree Programmes and 30 English Degree Programmes and 1 EMJMD included in the University educational catalogue.
